In 2016/17 we are expecting to continue to use the allocated funding to sustain the rapid improvement and enrichment in the learning experiences of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium Grant, and indeed all our pupils.

In addition to the strategies already in place we will provide:

- **Additional literacy support in Year 5 in the Summer term 2017**
- **Targeted booster groups for Year 6 children.**
- **EAL support for children new to English**
- **Curriculum enrichment including music, school trips, after school clubs, language clubs, theatre group projects**
- **Targeted CPD (Continued Professional Development)**
